As the church continued to grow, it became apparent that our property in downtown Palmetto could not support additional buildings or parking.

Looking at our "land-locked" acreage and realizing the need for additional space, we conducted a search for the appropriate site on which to relocate.

The first church building located on Toombs St. was dedicated.

A new sanctuary was built facing Center St. out of a new product called cinder blocks.



We contracted and finished the site work with curbs and a base coat of asphalt. The pavilion was completed and the ball fields ready to use, and we started having events at our future church location.

We held our first Sunday morning worship at our new location.

Land for our new church relocation was purchased one mile south of our Center St. location.

We began the second three-year capital campaign with a total commitment of \$1.6 million.

We contracted to build our first building, a Family Life and Worship Center.

OUR PLANS

We feel the excitement of what God is going to do in and through us at PBC as the visuals are revealed to us! These drawings and renderings are concepts of what we believe is a great vision given to us by God. These represent what could be. As with any building plan, the details of the building and the final cost of the project are subject to change, but we believe this represents the next leap of faith for us.

We are planning on a total expansion of 11,800 square feet that will provide room to grow for our preschoolers and kids up through 5th grade.

Included is a multipurpose room that seats 140, a nursery with a nursing mom's room, classrooms up to 470 square feet each, as well as storage and a new playground. In addition to meeting preschool and children's needs, there will also be four adult classrooms.

Our current building will also undergo a renovation to expand the lobby and introduce a new check-in location for our families as we drop off our kids to have fun and learn about Jesus.

This new chapter in our history will give us the room for growth that we need to do all that God has called us to do.







"We must invest in something bigger than ourselves."

Palmetto Baptist Church is everything to us. It is like an extended family. We dedicated our children here, they have come through the Children's Ministry and Youth Ministry, and both of them were saved and baptized here. We have both been involved with Sunday school and I'm involved with Women's Ministry among other things.

There's tremendous growth going on [around the church]. And so because of what we've done in the past and how great of a church we've been, I think our best years are in front of us. If we will be obedient, follow God, be willing to make sacrifices, and do the things that he's called us to do.

We know we have major needs in our Children's Ministry. We're out of room. I think we all know that we need to invest into our kids.

We've already seen the impact. Over the last two years, we've had more baptisms and more salvations than any time that I can remember in my history with the church. Because of this, I look at [sacrificial giving] as an investment. We invest in stocks or bonds or real estate or our families or whatever else it may be. This is bigger. This is investing in something beyond your family. It's investing in the kingdom of God. We are not only doing this for our own benefit. We're doing it so that others can ultimately know what we have. A life changing relationship with Christ. We must invest in something bigger than ourselves.

Sacrificially giving for [the cause of] Christ is absolutely worth it. He can do way more with it than we could ever do alone. Christ can take our gift and multiply it for his glory. The spiritual impact is endless.



"God's going to bless you if you do it with the right heart."

This church has been like family for us. It was so welcoming and just we knew right away it was a place that we wanted to raise our kids. What makes [PBC] special is that we are family. The people are here and they're they're ready to show what God can do.

We have to continue to grow and I think it will look like an expansion of our kids hallway. And what that will allow us to do is to grow in other areas. To really expand our Bible study classes and our student program.

The spiritual impact could be massive.

When we got here in 2016, we had gone through a series at a previous church where we were talking about tithing. And I had made that commitment to began tithing. In 2018 I lost my job.

What do I do? I'm the primary breadwinner. How do we continue to tithe? How do we pay our bills? I remembered what it's all about, and I gave anyway. And I think it was like two weeks later, we were here and sitting at Wednesday night dinner and a member of this church walks up and says, "Hey, I hear you're having a rough time."

I don't know how they knew, but they handed us a card and I didn't think anything of it. We got home and opened the card. It was a handwritten note and cash for the exact amount that I had to tithe. And so for me, that was like God giving that back. And I've never missed a month of tithe after that.

[This campaign] isn't about giving to a building. I think it's about giving faithfully. It's about giving with your heart instead of your mind or your wallet. Through that, God's going to do amazing things.

And so it's really just a step in faith. You commit to something, you pray about it, and you really just trust that God is going to bless, not only you, but the church, the community and the world.

Sacrificial giving means you're going above and beyond what you're called to do. You have to make some changes in your life. God's going to bless if you do it with the right heart.



"God will provide."

What excites us the most at PBC is that the Children's Ministry is amazing.

We don't have to worry because we know that what they're learning is biblical, and our kids are excited to be here.

[When it comes to this capital campaign], we think we will need to trust that **God will provide.** Our church has come a long way. And our faith has grown with that. Now it's time for us to take the next step and trust that God's going to lead us in the right direction.

It will need to be all hands on deck and we think it's going to be exciting!

It's something that our church has been looking forward to for many years now. It's not only proof that God is moving, but it's an opportunity for us to invest in the church and the community around us.

With this capital campaign, we are making an investment. We're not doing this to just give ourselves more room. We're really doing it so that God has the room He needs to do the work He's going to do in this community.

Tithing [for us] has never been a choice. It's always been a part of our marriage from the beginning.

We feel called to do it. We see Him working things out in our own life when we tithe. It's because we are being faithful.

It's not something that we do because we have to, but it's an opportunity for us to use what God has blessed us with to bless others. And that act of faith and tithing results in God blessing our lives and allows us to bless others.

We see it as giving this church the ability and the capability to reach more people for Jesus.

It's a test of faith but it's also an opportunity for us to see how God responds to our faith. And it's something that He uniquely challenges us to do. And if we're faithful in that, we're confident that He'll bless us.
